25th Annual Concerts on the Grass Series Concludes with Two Shows in Mendon

Board Member Earl Pearlman asked Nick Russell about his background at the Sept. 10 meeting of the ABMI Board of Directors.

Russell, who grew up in Bellingham, told Pearlman that he had volunteered at ABMI since he was twelve years old or so. He now runs LightWay, which handles the station's website and other tech services.

Board Member Diane Mela Souvanna made a motion to appoint Russell to a Bellingham seat on the ABMI Board of Directors. Pearlman seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

In other business, Pearlman asked about the stipend paid to Liz Wernig. Fleming said it is for her work as the director of the Miscoe Hill MultiMedia Club. Fleming said there is a similar position at Bellingham High for the supervisor of Hawk TV.

Fleming reported that the Bellingham Fire Marshall came to the studio and told him that all businesses on the street are being inspected





for fire code. Fleming said he followed the checklist for such things as smoke detectors, fire-retardant on the studio curtains, and getting rid of old paint cans.
