## **Stephen Ministry Discussed**

Two representatives from the Slatersville Congregational Church in Slatersville, R.I. appeared at a shoot of *In The Spotlight* March 29 to talk about a caregiving group called the Stephen Ministry.

The Stephen Ministry is comprised of well-trained lay caregivers who provide one-to-one Christian care to people experiencing various difficulties in life.

The Reverend Eileen Morris told host Linda Trudeau that the goal of the organization is to make sure that crucial support is given to struggling people in the congregation and throughout the community.

Bob Villiard, a pastor in the church and a Stephen Minister, spoke about helping people in crisis. He said that his work of extended involvement in these situations has been one of the most rewarding experiences of his life.

A half-day introductory workshop for the ministry takes place April 29 at the church. More information is available at stephenministry.org.

# ABMI Board Approves Budget; Includes New Streaming Channel

The ABMI Board of Directors voted unanimously at their meeting March 9 to approve the budget presented by Station Manager Patrick Fleming for the upcoming fiscal year.

Fleming pointed out that the budget is a "guideline," and that the Board has final approval of any large expenditure in any case.

In other business, board member Earl Pearlman asked what the "Subscriptions" item was in the Treasurer's Report of Dec. 2016. Fleming said it was for subscriptions to magazines, and online programs like QuickBooks.

Pearlman asked why the station was doing "infomercials" for Peregrine Energy. Fleming said the interview with the Peregrine representative was requested by the town of Bellingham. Board member Nick Russell asked whether this might be against station policy. Fleming said it wasn't because the town benefits from it.

Board member Jer-





reme Cooper asked what is going on with the broken camera. Fleming said volunteer Derek Berchtold accidentally bumped the bleachers at a BHS basketball game and knocked down someone else's camera. ABMI is having the camera repaired.

Cooper asked about the new show, *Kev's Korner*. Publicity Director Steve Saraceno said the show is well-produced even though Rep. Kevin Kuros appears to be new to studio production.

Russell said it is nice that Greg Cooney can perform at Kids Nite this summer in the Concerts on the Grass series.

Russell asked how the new studio desk was working out. Fleming said it is very versatile -- its arrangement can be altered for different hosts.

Fleming said he added a line in the producers' prop budget that includes advertising.

Board member Sue Carlson said on March 25 there is a Valley Chapel ceremony to celebrate Mendon's 350th anniversary. She asked whether ABMI could cover it. Production Coordinator Jeff Paul said he would do so.

Fleming said the ABMI fiscal year ends March 31.
