ABMI Board of Directors Appove Upgrade for Broadcast Pics Unit

The ABMI Board of Directors approved a motion made at the Oct. 30 meeting authorizing the expenditure of up to \$30,000 to upgrade the control room at the studio.

Station Manager Patrick Fleming told the Board that Production Coordinator Jeff Paul recently experienced trouble booting up Broadcast Pics. The unit is 8 years old and its malfunctions have interfered with several shows.

Fleming said he wants to get rid of the old composite monitors, replace the computer, and update the camera monitors in the control room. The replacement of Broadcast Pics, along with the purchase of two Dell monitors, converters, installation, tech support, and warranty would cost approximately \$26,000.

Board Treasurer Jereme Cooper made a motion to authorize the upgrade at a cost not to exceed \$30,000. Motion passed unanimously.

In other business, Fleming said ABMI





will supply the Miscoe Hill MultiMedia Club with a 27" iMac with Final Cut Pro X installed. The station will also provide a camera in the \$200-\$300 range. Custodians at the school are cleaning out the room where the studio will be located.

Fleming told the Board a new bulk copier is needed in Publicity Director Steve Saraceno's office. Fleming has been researching prices for a new copier. He said he saw a used model selling for around \$2,000.

Fleming told the Board he would like to purchase two modulators at approximately \$1,000 apiece. He said modulators can last years but they run "24/7" and may crash at any time. One of the new modulators would be used as a spare.

Board Member Sue Carlson made a motion to purchase the two modulators. Vice-President Earl Pearlman seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

Fleming asked the Board whether he should stop buying Verizon cards to help with live transmission. Cooper made a motion to table the issue until next meeting. Pearlman seconded. The motion passed.
