31st Annual Santa's Elves Telethon



On the night of Tuesday, December 5, 2017 the Bellingham Women of Today held their annual Telethon at the ABMI studio at 10 William Way in Bellingham, to help raise money for needy area families. Over \$3,000 dollars were donated over the phones and in person, not to mention thousands of dollars more worth of toys brought in by local scouting groups and youth organizations. Linda Trudeau once again served as host of the event. Featured were area performers, town politicians, local business people, and charitable groups.



Saraceno Tells Board that Telethon Raised Over \$3,000 Plus Toys

Publicity Director Steve Saraceno told the ABMI Board of Directors at the Jan. 11 meeting that the *Santa's Elves Telethon* garnered over \$3,000 in pledged donations. Saraceno said this figure does not include the cash value of the many gifts donated by local Scout groups and other community organizations.

Board Treasurer Jereme Cooper asked Production Coordinator Jeff Paul how the cablecast of the Telethon turned out. Paul reported that the production went smoothly. Station Manager Patrick Fleming said it was the smoothest shoot in the past few years, with no last minute surprises.

In other business, Cooper asked how the music loop for the video bulletin board was working. Fleming answered that it is functioning well.

Board President Nick Russell asked how the printer in Saraceno's office was doing. Fleming said it is working well now, though it will



have to be replaced at some point down the line. The cost would be around \$4,500 for a comparable model.

Cooper asked about the plans for upgrading the board in the Control Room. Fleming said he would like to upgrade Broadcast Pics, the monitors, and the hard drive.

Cooper asked Paul how things went with the *Bellingham Sports Special* that Pete Royce produced featuring the BHS Hall of Fame Committee. Paul said the committee members came in and chatted with Royce. One committee member was Kevin Grupposo. Cooper noted that Grupposo has done good work at ABMI in the past.

Fleming told the Board that *Real Estate and Beyond* producer Mike Shain wanted to know if he could donate money from his production budget to the local food pantry. The Board decided against this, as the budget is intended only for public access purposes.

The Board passed a motion allowing Shain to advertise his show in the *Bellingham Bulletin*, with a suggestion he try the *Mendon Town Crier* as well.
