Cooper, Russell, and Carlson Gain Re-election to Board Seats

Jereme Cooper and Nick Russell won re-election to Bellingham board seats and incumbent Sue Carlson won her Mendon seat in a vote that took place at the ABMI Annual Membership Meeting May 31.

The seats all carry a three-year term.

In the vote for Board Officers, Russell gained re-election as President, Earl Pearlman gained re-election as Vice-President, Cooper gained re-election as Treasurer, and Diane Mela Souvanna gained re-election as Secretary.

In other business, Pearlman asked whether the digital signboard had been installed on the Rt. 140 sign. Station Manager Patrick Fleming said the digital sign is something that as yet has only been proposed.

Cooper asked about the coverage of the Bellingham Memorial Day Parade. Production Coordinator Jeff Paul said it went well, though the Keynote Speaker for the parade did not show.





Publicity Director Steve Saraceno distributed scholarship applications to the Board for review.

In Old Business, Fleming reported that the recent meeting on contract negotiations featured a no-show from Verizon. Fleming said he submitted the wish list as to future needed expenditures. Fleming said the contract with Verizon is the one that is currently up for renewal. The contract with Comcast is not up for renewal for fifteen months, but Comcast is taking part in the negotiations because of the "level playing field" condition which matches both providers to the same funding commitments.

Fleming said the next contract negotiation meeting has not been settled upon as yet.

Fleming showed the report from the Building Inspector.
Fleming said the report was very thorough and detected no major problems with the building and grounds. Fleming said the minor problems had already been mentioned to the Board -- fence rotting, cracks in the asphalt, etc. Fleming said he will lop off some overhanging branches.
