Bellingham Celebrates Veterans As Part of 300th Anniversary



The Veterans Day Celebration Nov. 11 at the BHS Auditorium honored Vietnam Vets and others as part of the town of Bellingham's 300th Anniversary Celebration. ABMI-TV is currently playing *The Wall That Heals in Bellingham*, a documentary look at the visit of the Wall That Heals to Bellingham Aug. 23-26. Board Votes to Purchase New Drone for \$300

At the Nov. 5 meeting of the ABMI Board of Directors, Production Coordinator Tyler McMinniman told the Board about a drone he had been reseraching. It costs \$300 and is small enough so that licenses and operating permits are not required.

Board Treasurer Jereme Cooper asked whether the drone has user-friendly controls. McMinniman said yes. Cooper suggested that if the station decides to purchase the drone, only staff members should be allowed to use it. Station Manager Patrick Fleming agreed.

Cooper made a motion to purchase the drone for approximately \$300. Board Vice-President Diane Mela Souvanna seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

In other business, Board President Tracy Aicardi asked if there was any trouble with the bank changing our checks over. Fleming said there was no problem.

Cooper asked why the station's phone bill is \$440.





Fleming said that covers 5 phone lines.

Cooper asked McMinniman how coverage of The Wall That Heals is coming along. McMinniman said he shot a lot of footage which he will edit according to the wishes of the veteran Jim Hastings. There may be one general piece to fit into an hour slot, and then maybe a piece on each landmark day the Wall was here.

Fleming reported on the contract discussions with Comcast and Verizon. He said Comcast told him that they are in it for the long run and are seeking a ten-year contract. Verizon is adopting a waitand-see attitude and only seeks a five year contract. Cooper said that Fleming should run the contracts by an independent lawyer before we sign anything. Fleming said he could contact the cable access lawyer who works out of California that we have contacted before.

Fleming said there was an issue with the Mendon Town Hall where the hub was connected incorrectly. The issue has been resolved.
