Another show will be produced by ABMI sportscaster Pete Royce. He plans to interview sports celebrities and have ABMI Production Coordinator Tyler McMinniman edit the footage for presentation on the Public Channel.

The third new show will focus on the Environment. It is to be produced by Nina Boucher.

In other business, Board Treasurer Jereme Cooper asked McMinniman how the new drone camera is working out. McMinniman said it was a good piece of equipment. Cooper suggested that the drone camera might help to create new openings for shows. Board Member Earl Pearlman





asked how big it was. Fleming said it is small but folds out.

Cooper asked McMinniman how the Illumination Parade went. McMinniman said it was really cold so they moved the Santa line quickly.

Cooper said it was nice that the high school allowed the van to go inside the garage for the Bellingham Town Meeting. Fleming said it helped to protect the equipment from the cold temperatures that night.
