During the Sept. 8 meeting of the ABMI Board of Directors, Board Vice-President Jereme Cooper asked Production Coordinator Tyler Mc-Minniman about the recent tour of Polar Park in Worcester.

McMinniman reported that announcer Pete Royce was able to gain access usually not given on the tour for the general public. The finished piece, entitled *Polar Park Tour*, has been running on the Public Channel since September.

In other business, Board Member Diane Mela Souvanna inquired about the status of the Nexus playback system. Fleming said it is still functional for the time being.

Board Secretary Earl Pearlman asked about former board member Brian Sutherland. Station Manager Patrick Fleming reported that Sutherland is doing well.





Cooper asked about summer concert volunteer Joe Cavallero. Fleming said Cavallero was a member of the BHS video club, Hawk TV.

Cooper asked about the search for a BHS Pops Night production from 2001 or so. Publicity Director Steve Saraceno said he searched the tape archives but was unable to find anything labeled as such. He found some unlabeled tapes from that period and will have the person looking for the tape come to the studio to see if Pops Night is on any of the tapes.

Fleming reported that there is an automatic camera setup at BHS that can be used for coverage of games at the field. Cooper asked whether the setup was permanent. Mc-Minniman said yes, the school uses it for several sports.

Fleming said the Bellingham Town Hall upgrade will be done once construction is completed.
