Honored during the ceremony were Staff Sergeant Kyle J. Reitnaur, U.S. Army, Chris Condon, U.S. Navy, and Margaret Johnson, U.S. Army.

Reitnaur is currently assigned as a non-commissioned officer at the Natick Soldier Systems Center. He has conducted research that has led to changes in the Army physical fitness test as well as the Army body composition
